

**NO-WAKE POLICY; HOGSETT LAKE  
TOWNSHIP OF SCHOOLCRAFT, MICHIGAN  
ord. no. 82 eff. Aug. 16, 1981**

An Ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Schoolcraft Township, Kalamazoo County; enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, as amended (M.S.A. 18.1287 (17)), being identical to State Administrative Rules filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

**THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHOOLCRAFT ORDAINS:**

**Sec. 1. DEFINITIONS.**

All words and phrases used in this Ordinance shall be construed and have the same meanings as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, as amended, M.S.A. 18.1287 (8).

**Sec. 2. REGULATION NO. 39, KALAMAZOO COUNTY.**

R 281.739.10 Hogsett Lake; hours for high-speed boating and water skiing.

Rule 10. On the waters of Hogsett Lake, Sections 3 and 4, T4S, R11W, Schoolcraft Township, Kalamazoo County, it is unlawful, between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. of the following day, to:

- (a) Operate a vessel at high speed.
- (b) Have in tow, or otherwise assist in the propulsion of, a person on water skis, a water sled, kite, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

**Sec. 3. REPEAL.**

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Sec. 4. PENALTY.**

Violations of this Ordinance are a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or said fine, costs of prosecution, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

**Sec. 5. SEVERABILITY.**

This Ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable. If any part of this Ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected hereby.

**Sec. 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the Commercial-Express newspaper.
